O Priorie for Priorie Prioritise 'inclusion development' for all staff annually and train staff to deliver bespoke & inclusive practice.

Utilise the 'Derby Inclusion Directory' to access training and support.

Reflect on practice, audit provision/cycle of support, identify development opportunities, and implement change.

> Attend network meetings to share success, learning and best practice.

Someone who will work with school leaders to:

Ensure all staff are inclusion champions.

Ensure school policy and practice is inclusive, including admission and in year fair access.

Ensure the views of all members of the school community are valued.

Ensure language is consistent, accessible, and supportive.

Embed a 'flexibly consistent' behavior/relationships protocol, focusing on kindness.

Create a positive supportive

Ensure access for all to a broad, balanced, and effective curriculum.

Promote and support mental health and well-being.
